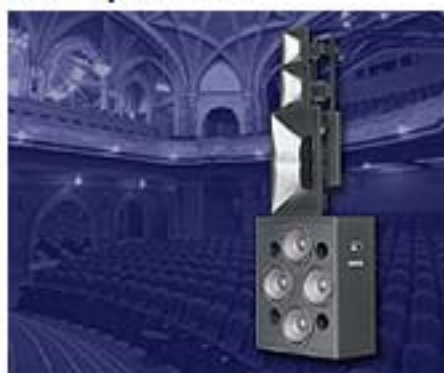

IDI Uses NIR Spectrometer Technology for Precise Testing of Thermoset Molding Compounds

IDI has recently made a capital equipment investment in a Fourier Transform Near Infrared Spectrometer (FT-NIR). The machine is used to test raw materials, pastes, and special additives that are used in Sheet Molding Compounds (SMC) and Bulk Molding Compounds (BMC). IDI is one of only two companies in the industry that owns this unit, enabling the company to control properties that directly affect quality to the end-user of their products.
